



HOW OUR FUNDING MODEL WORKS

The average cost per year to provide the Cristo Rey Columbus High School experience to one student is \$20,000. As a school committed to its mission of serving all families regardless of financial ability, this means that our funding model is unique to many traditional private schools.

While families pay a small tuition fee, the majority of the student's tuition is covered through our Professional Work-Study Program, EdChoice and donor support.

PROFESSIONAL WORK-STUDY PROGRAM



All Cristo Rey Columbus students spend five days a month at a professional job. Funding from companies and underwriters goes toward the cost of a student's tuition.

EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIPS



All Cristo Rey Columbus students qualify for some level of the EdChoice scholarship through the state of Ohio, contributing at maximum \$8,408 each year.

PHILANTHROPY



After PWSP, EdChoice and a small family contribution is made, there is a funding gap of \$5,000/year per student that is funded through donor dollars.

HOW WE PREPARE OUR STUDENTS




- Students attend our 8-day Summer Success Institute to **prepare them for working in an office** prior to starting their job.
